

SEA RAY 40 MOTOR YACHT

There's plenty of value packed into this 40-footer



For 45 years Sea Ray has been building some of the most stylish pleasure vessels on the market. Its line includes everything from 18' sport boats to 68' luxury yachts, and all are built to the standards in aesthetics, engineering and technology that have ranked the company highest in customer satisfaction by J.D. Power and Associates.

ON DECK By moving the helm station far aft, putting the master stateroom directly below it, and tapering the large forward deck gently to the bow, Sea Ray has managed to pack in a large amount of interior space without detracting from the clean looks of the new wedge-shaped 40-footer. As well as tons of deck space, the 40's wide integral swim grid and stairway to the covered bridge means there's plenty of room grouped around this area for fun in the sun. And, if it happens to be raining, there's still plenty of covered space for entertaining. And all the party fixtures are right at hand, including a wet bar with sink and icemaker.



The helm station features the usual amenities as well as SmartCraft instrumentation and diagnostics, including System View for easy systems monitoring.

INTERIOR The saloon, located amidships, makes you want to just sit back, soak up the luxury and enjoy the pleasure of simply being there. It features deep-pile carpet throughout, plus two cozy, curved Ultraleather settees—one of which can be converted into a double berth—and a small dinette table and two plush portable seats. The entertainment centre includes a flat screen TV/DVD and Sirius satellite receiver. The galley is stepped down to starboard at the forward end of the saloon. It boasts a breakfast bar, solid surface countertops, convection-microwave oven, large dual-voltage refrigerator/freezer and two-burner electric stove. The forward guest stateroom has plenty of space and twin beds (filler cushions allow the starboard bed to convert to a full-size bed) and its own flat screen TV/DVD and entertainment centre. The aft master stateroom has an

island queen bed with innerspring mattress, dresser, vanity and full length hanging locker. The head has a VacuFlush unit, separate shower stall and top-of-the-line Grohe faucets. Two oval port lights are on either side, and a large aft window looks astern over the swim grid.

ENGINE While base power is twin 8.1 S Horizon MerCruiser gas engines, all West Coast models are brought in with twin Cummins 480CE diesel inboards that drive four-blade Nibral props. This gives a top speed of approximately 35-37 mph at 2,600 rpm and a comfortable cruising speed of 30-33 mph at 2,300 rpm. 480CE's burn approximately 15 gph each at 2,300 rpm. Access is through hatches in the saloon sole. Trim tabs are standard, as is a 10 kw Kohler generator and air conditioning. Sea Ray's 40 Motor Yacht should appeal to anyone wanting luxury, ample room for guests and family, and all the amenities of a well-found yacht. Base price is \$609,887.
